

## STUDENTS

### Jacob K. Javits Fellowship Program, Department of Education

For study in the arts, humanities, and social sciences. For doctoral and Master of Fine Arts students. Applicants must be in first year of doctoral study or not have applied to graduate school yet. Support for up to four years. \$30,000/ year plus tuition. 50 awards annually.  
*October 5 (annual).*

## FACULTY

### Supporting Universities to Partner across the Pacific, USAID

For collaboration with universities in Indonesia on development-related issues.  
*September 8, 2009; February 26, 2010; June 25, 2010*

### Michigan Applied Public Policy Grants, MSU Institute for Public Policy and Social Research

For policy-relevant research which will aid economic recovery. \$1,000-\$15,000, with an additional \$10,000 available for survey research. One team member must be MSU faculty member.  
*September 28 (annual)*

### Ocean Exploration (OE) Program, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration

To investigate... poorly-known... areas of the ocean and Great Lakes through interdisciplinary exploration, and to advance and disseminate knowledge of the ocean environment and its physical, chemical, and biological resources. Focus on ecosystems.

Pre-proposals (required) due October 8, 2009; full proposals due December 7, 2009

### Dynamics of Host-Associated Microbial Communities (R01), NIH

Letters of Intent (not required) due December 15, 2009; proposals due January 15, 2010

### Science Master's Program, NSF

For programs which prepare students for STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) careers in business, industry, government agencies, and non profit organizations.

Note: MSU internal deadline is **September 5** to OVPRGS; NSF Letter of Intent is due October 5

### Pesticide Safety Program, EPA

Funds a center which will develop health and safety programs aimed at reducing exposure to pesticides for multiple groups. Not research.

### Charles A. Ryskamp Research Fellowships, American Council of Learned Societies

A year of research support for untenured faculty in the social sciences and humanities.

*October 2 (annual)*

### Sabbatical Fellowships in the Humanities and Social Sciences, American Philosophical Society

Supports leaves during the academic year 2010-2011 or for the calendar year 2011.
